

# PEER ASSESSMENT RUBRIC

Score your classmates on how well they present their chosen volunteer organization. As you listen to each presentation, you must consider what your peers are saying as well as how they are saying it. This rubric gives you three categories within which to award points. Think carefully as you award points and be prepared to back up your decision with reasons.

4	<p><b>EXCELLENT</b></p> <p>There was a strong sense of cooperation among all group members. Everyone fulfilled the responsibility of their roles.</p>	<p><b>EXCELLENT</b></p> <p>Given the facts presented by each group, I felt that this organization would be a great one to volunteer with in the future.</p>	<p><b>EXCELLENT</b></p> <p>Volunteering with this organization will have an important impact on our community. The time required is well suited to us as students.</p>
