Why is kindness important?

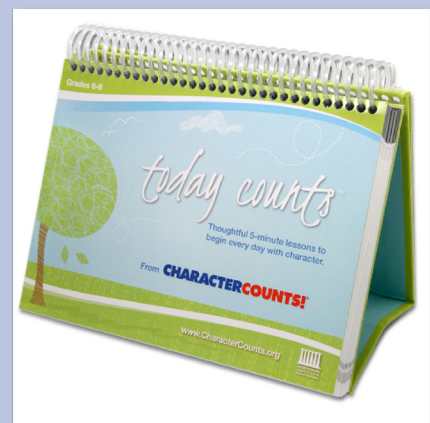
Have you experienced a “kindness boomerang”? Share your experience with the class. How is kindness contagious?
